Biosafety Guidelines for Work Related to Modern Biotechnology

Research Institute for Health Sciences (RIHS)

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The Research Institute for Health Sciences; RIHS aims to provide modern biotechnology research operations management of faculty, researchers, students, personnel, research performer, and related persons for orderliness, security, effectiveness, and operate based on the latest global organization biosafety guidelines, which are the Guidelines for Research Involving Recombinant or Synthetic Nucleic Acid Molecules, 2016 edition of the National Institute of Health; NIH and Biosafety in microbiological and Biomedical Laboratories, 5th edition of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention; CDC.

The Research Institute for Health Sciences, Walailak University has established guidelines and processes for permission, and the modern biotechnology operations are as follows:

1. For research conducting, the researcher must request permission and prepare the details relying on the request for research on organisms, genetically modified organisms; GMOs, and related products which are attached to this announcement. The researcher will be able to conduct the research after the request has been approved by the Institutional Biosafety Committee; IBC.
2. The researcher must strictly operate based on the latest global organization biosafety guidelines, which are the Guidelines for Research Involving Recombinant or Synthetic Nucleic Acid Molecules, 2016 edition of the National Institute of Health; NIH and Biosafety in microbiological and Biomedical Laboratories, 5th edition of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention; CDC.
3. In the case of unforeseen problems with biosafety during research operations, the researcher must immediately notify the Institutional Biosafety Committee to stop conducting research and solve problems hingeing on the emergency measures procedures.

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
