

Announcement of Guidelines of the Research Institute of Health Science Issue 2/2017 Biosafety Guidelines for Work Related to Modern Biotechnology Research Institute for Health Sciences (RIHS)

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The Research Institute for Health Sciences; RIHS recognizes the importance of laboratory safety for research conducted by faculty, researchers, students, and related persons to ensure safety based on International Standard for Laboratories; ISO and comply with the Enhancement of Safety Practice of Research Laboratory; ESPReL. Thus, the following policies and guidelines have been prescribed as follows:

1. To support the issuance of announcements, rules, regulations, and guidelines for laboratory safety based on International Standard for Laboratories; ISO.

2. To promote elevating the standard of laboratory safety rely on the National Enhancement of Safety Practice of Research Laboratory; ESPReL.

3. The Research of Health Sciences supports basic laboratory safety training to operators and related persons.

4. To support preserving the environment, update facility and laboratory safety infrastructure.

5. To encourage operators and related persons to recognize and prioritize laboratory safety by following the rules, regulations, and manual of laboratory safety.

6. To encourage systematic information management and document.

7. To encourage an assessment on compliance with rules, and laboratory safety regulations according to safety standards.
