

Announcement CB Golden Awards, Walailak University B.E. 2560 (A.D. 2017)

Walailak University aims to emphasize the importance of research publication by launching an incentive program to motivate all individuals at Walailak University with an academic appointment to create high-quality research articles published within international databases. To be consistent with the promotion of quality research, the program offers an award for research publication with the following conditions.

- 1. This announcement is entitled "CB Golden Awards, Walailak University".
- 2. This announcement shall be implemented from the day following the date of its announcement.
- 3. The following definitions describe the standard terms in regard to the award:
- Article means Full research article or review article that has been accepted by Quartile 1 journals since 1 January 2021 onwards.

4. Criteria for Eligible Applicants

Health Sciences (RIHS)

- 4.1. The applicant must be an academic employee of Walailak University during the application.
- 4.2. The applicant must be the first author or the corresponding author of at least10 published articles.

5. Criteria for the Applied Article

- 5.1. The article must be conducted during the applicant's period as an employee of Walailak University.
- 5.2. The article must neither be a part nor the whole of the thesis pursuant to the applicant's course of study.
- 6. Award Determination Procedure

- 6.1. The eligible applicant must submit forms and supporting documentation provided by the awards review committee to the panel of the applicant's school or college for an initial screening. The approved application is then reviewed by the Research Institute for Health Sciences (RIHS).
- 6.2. The application form, which has been screened by RIHS, is forwarded to the awards committee who selects the laureates and makes recommendations to the Academic Senate committee.
- 6.3. After the Academic Senate committee finalizes the list of laureates, the Walailak University Council makes the final approval.
- 7. The award ceremony will be held at the commencement ceremony; hence, the laureates must attend the commencement ceremony to receive the award.

The award may be canceled if the notification of intent to withdraw the award as determined by the committee in writing shows that the laureate does not qualify for the award.

In case of any dispute, the Academic Senate committee is in the position of authority over this announcement, and the judgement of the Academic Senate committee shall be final.
